Ownership	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Be on time -Be ready to learn -Be prepared to learn -Be responsible for yourself -Be responsible for your work 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Keep the hallways and stairwells clean. -Don't throw anything on the floor. -Don't scratch or make the floors or walls dirty -Don't touch the walls or lean on them -Keep your personal belongings in your personal space. -Never swing your backpacks or lunch boxes and never use the wheels to make others trip. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Flush the toilet/make sure it flushes automatically -Wash your hands with soap and water -Dry your hands with paper towels and throw away used paper towels 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Protect your passwords. -Take responsibility for how you act online. -Tell an adult immediately if you access inappropriate content. -Set your accounts to "private" to limit the access to your information to only friends you know and family. -Follow teacher directions when using technology 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Use appropriate words and actions on the playground -Ask an adult if you are not sure your recess activity is appropriate -Let an adult know if you are having problems on the playground 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Clean up after ourselves -Carefully hand our trays to an adult -Eat our own food -Eat our food so our brains and bodies are ready to work 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Be watching for your ride to reach the front of the line -Be ready to go when your name is called -Wait for the adult in charge to open the car door and let you in or out -Be responsible for your belongings 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Take care of your belongings backpack, coat, etc. -Look around your seat area before you leave the bus so you don't leave your belongings behind. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Be a good audience member by listening to the presentation and watching attentively -Take care of your own behavior and don't allow others to distract you

Instead, take one stair step at a time while going up or down -Never use the ledge of the stairs 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Use the restroom only when you need to -Stay only as long as you need to -Voices off 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Tell an adult right away if you read or see anything on the Internet that makes you feel sad, uncomfortable, scared, or confused. -Check with an adult before downloading or installing software -Speak up if you know that someone is being cyberbullied or is cyberbullying another. -Take care of all equipment and use it correctly 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Be responsible for your own choices and behaviors -If you make a mistake, own up to it and apologize if necessary -Remember to always be honest and tell the truth 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Follow the rules -Keep our food in the cafeteria -Use sanitizer -Turn off our voices when the lights go out 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Stay in the designated area and wait calmly and patiently for your ride -Keep hands and feet to yourself -Follow the directions of the adults in charge wearing the orange vests 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Line up in your bus line and wait patiently - hands to yourself, nice voices and listen to the adult in charge. -Do the right thing, even when no one is looking -Solve your problems by making a good choice or ask the bus driver to help you 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Watch for the Wolford 5: Voices are off, eyes on speaker, listening ears, bodies still and ready to learn/enjoy the program
Kindness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Treat others as you would like to be treated 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Be quiet. Don't disturb others in the classroom -Be courteous. Allow others to go in front of you and be patient if people walk slower than you. -If you stop or get out of line, be kind and go to the end of the line. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Clean up after yourself -Don't write on the walls, doors, etc. -Report graffiti or inappropriate behavior to an adult 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Share and take turns with technology equipment. -Leave equipment ready for the next user. -Use kind words when you type online and on assignments. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Be a good friend to others -Honor other students feelings -Treat others the way you want to be treated -Remember to take care of the playground equipment and our environment 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Help those around us -Sit with students who are sitting alone -Be friendly to those in need -Tell the lunch clerk our last name first 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Be helpful -Use a nice tone of voice -Use good manners 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Be helpful, use kind words and a nice voice 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Sit flat on the floor so everyone has a chance to watch and enjoy the program -Respond positively to the presenter, even if you may not have enjoyed the program
Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Keep hands and feet to self -Use materials and equipment appropriately -Follow adult directions 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Always walk forward -Move just like cars on the road by staying on the right hand side on the hallway and going up and down the stairs, that makes the traffic of people move smoothly. -If you need to make a turn at a corner, wait for people going the other way to pass before you turn across the hallway. -Keep hands and feet to self. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Use the facilities appropriately -Flush the toilet/make sure it flushed automatically -Wash your hands with soap and dry them -Be careful not to splash water on the floor -Use the bathroom for its intended purpose Report unsafe behavior to an adult 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Keep personal information private. -Ask an adult before you send pictures or information online. -Tell an adult immediately if someone you meet online asks to meet you in person or you want to meet them. -Always remember that people online may not be who they say they are. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Stay in areas where adults can see you and always know where you are -Ask permission if you have to enter the building -Leave snow, sticks, pinecones and other objects on the ground -Use the playground equipment safely and appropriately -Stay away from animals, strangers and tell an adult if you see one. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Stay in our seats -Raise our hand when we need something -Keep our hands and feet to ourselves -Let an adult know if we spill -Respect the allergy free table 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Stay in the designated area -Use the crosswalks -Wait for your car to reach the front of the line and the adult in charge to let you in or out -Stay seated and use your seatbelt 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Stay in your bus line and wait in line for adult directions -Follow the bus rules - sit on your bottom, face the front of the bus, keep hands and feet to yourself. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Keep your hand and feet to yourself and out of the way of others -Watch where you step -Enter and exit in an orderly way
