I want to welcome you to preschool this year! Some of you are returning and for some this is your child's first year in school, and I want you to know how excited I am to work with your child and your family this year! The following will provide you with the information you need to make the transition from summer to school more successful. Please make note of each on your calendars.

Wednesday, August 14th: We will be having a meet and greet on August 14th at Edith Wolford for your preschool student!

- 4:30-5:00- Our AM class meet and greet
- 5:00-5:30- Presentation by our new principal in the school gym
- 5:30-6:00- Our PM class meet and greet

Please feel free to stop in during your child's designated times above. This will be a time for me to meet you, for you and your child to see our classroom, pay class supply fees to the office, and for me to pass out paperwork that will need to be completed. If you cannot attend, I will get the paperwork to you on the first day of school.

Enclosed you will find a Health Form that must be updated **annually** and signed by a physician and a parent or guardian. This paper needs to be completed by the first day of preschool this year, or your child will be unable to start school until it is turned in!

Monday, August 19th: First day of school for preschoolers! I would also love to have parents come in on our first day for about an hour. First, you and your child will take part in our opening greeting and then work together to find things in our classroom as you complete a classroom hunt. After our hunt, we will read a story with the children, and then it will be time to leave your preschooler with us. This will help your child feel more comfortable in our classroom and will give you a chance to see where your child will be spending their time! AM class parents, if you are able to join us, we would love to have you from 8:45-9:15. PM class parents, we would love to have you join us from 12:45-1:15.

Thursday, August 22nd: Elementary Testing days. No school for preschoolers.

Monday, September 2nd: Labor Day Holiday. No school for students or staff.

Tuesday, September 3rd: Staff Training Day. No school for students.
