**SUBJECT:** Asbestos Notification

In 1986 the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) was signed into law requiring all non-profit Public and Private Schools (K-12) to inspect for the presence of Asbestos Containing Building Materials (ACBM). Academy District 20 has completed the initial inspection on all buildings in the district and continues to monitor the status of any materials found during inspections.

Construction of your building was completed in August 2004 and no asbestos containing materials were specified for use in construction. Academy District 20 is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for our students and the administration is interested in your concerns and suggestions.
